On behalf of Clarkston Tennis Club I would like to welcome your child to the club and provide you with some information about our activities.

The club provides opportunities for all young tennis players aged 4 and 18 to receive coaching and competition in mini red, orange and green competitions and for juniors over 10 years old in the the West of Scotland Tennis leagues and other organised competition. All coaching is by qualified coaches who are trained and have been screened for their suitability to work with young people. We welcome parents to all training and competitions and value your support. We are keen to involve parents in the club and always welcome your input. Below is some information on training times and dates, and details regarding travel arrangements, kit and club registration.

Club sessions and activities take place at the club every day according to the advertised schedule. Your child should play in comfortable sports clothing and non-marking trainers or tennis shoes. It is a good idea to bring a drink on court with you - but no breakable bottles please.

Arrangements should be made for your child to travel to and from training sessions and matches. It is important that children arrive on time and are collected promptly at the end of each session, if they are not making their own way home. If you are going to be late picking your child up, please contact the coach in charge of the session and let them know.

The cost of coaching sessions and competition fees are advertised by email and on the noticeboard. The club has a small annual membership fee, which should be paid by 1st April each year. Discounted membership is available and also Parent of Child membership which allow you to take to the court with your children.

If you have not yet completed the necessary junior registration forms these can be found on the website or on the club notice boards. For the safety of your child, it is important we are informed of any medical conditions or allergies. This information is treated confidentially and only used should your child fall ill or be involved in an accident while at the club. If you supply an email address we will send you regular electronic newsletters to keep you up to date.
